Gameplay
The game is played from a first-person perspective and scrolls horizontally in two directions as different enemy creatures, possess soldiers, human vehicles and foreign returns attack a character player. Alien Brigade can be played with the Joystick Atari 7800 or with a light weapon Atari. The game has five levels and four difficulty modes. [2]
The initial mission was to rescue the hostages from an enemy camp, but the game then progressed to a coastal battle, an underwater melee, a showdown in an underground mine, and then a final battle at the top of the mountain. Adding to the challenge, the player should be careful not to shoot innocent bystanders. [2]
Between levels, the player is informed by the commanding officer who advises the situation and assesses the player's performance at the level. A host alien brigade is reviewed in the September issue of Atari Magazine of Atari Explorer. Funkmaster V from Wrestling With Ghosts looks at the Atari 7800 Forever game and gives it 4 out of 5, and ranks it as the 10th best officially licensed game on the system. [4]
